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SPAY/ NEUTER STANDARD OPERATION PROCEDURES (SOPs)

STEP 1: FIRST CONTACT / INTRODUCTION.

1. Welcome the owner of the dog to the clinic.
2. Ensure the dog is safely handled by the owner and it has a leash.
3. If the dog is aggressive, use a muzzle/ restraining rod/restraining net and sedate the animal.
4. Maintain 5 foot distance between you and the animal.

STEP 2: CLINICAL EXAMINATION

1. Once the dog is calm and relaxed approach the dog together with the owner.
2. Take all the history of the dog from the owner using the dog clinical examination form.
3. Carry out general examination of the dog
4. Proceed to clinical examination of the animal
5. If the animal passes all the required clinical parameters, proceed to step 3.
6. If the animal does not pass all the required clinical parameters, medical treatment and advice the owner accordingly.

STEP 3: PREPARATION FOR ANAESTHESIA

1. Ensure all equipment and drugs are available and you have extra. (Refer to the Anaesthesia form)
2. Restrain the animal
3. Sedate the animal to ensure its calm(in case you did not sedate it at Step 1)
4. Administer the anaesthesia and lay the animal in a comfortable area.
5. Once the anaesthesia is effective, move the animal (patient) to the operating table.

STEP 4: PREPARATION FOR SURGERY

1. Lie the animal on its back and restrain all the four limbs.
2. Using a mild disinfectant, clean the surgery site.
3. Sterilize the area with alcohol 80%.
4. Using a sterile shaver, cut all hair for that surround the (work area) surgery site.
5. Monitor the respiratory rate and rhythm, heart rate and temperature every 5 minutes and record the data correctly.
